Instructions:

Choose one of the PSA project ideas from the list below. You will work together with the others who have chosen that idea to create your PSA. Don't just choose an idea because your friends are in that group; choose an idea that you interests you. But, there can be no more than 6 to a group. As a group, choose one of the topics from the list below to create your project around. Hurry and tell me which topic you have chosen because there will only be one group per topic.

In your project, you must tell your audience the main conflict involved with this topic, your stance on this topic, a possible solution for this conflict and information on what your audience can do to help.

You will have two days in class to work on this project and then you will present your project to class. Your presentation must be at least 2 minutes long, but cannot go longer than 5 minutes. Make sure your project is really good, because whoever comes up with the best project will get extra credit on their assignment. This project will be worth 30 points.

Project Ideas:

1. Create a two-five minute COMMERCIAL using a video camera.
2. Create a WEBSITE or BLOG.
3. Write a NEWSLETTER or PAMPHLET.
4. Compile songs and create a SOUNDTRACK.
5. Write a SONG and perform it for the class.
6. Create a piece of PERFORMANCE ART and perform it for the class (i.e. interpretive dance, skit, beat poem).
7. Create a POSTER or BILLBOARD.
8. Write a short PICTURE BOOK and ILLUSTRATE it.
9. Make a COLLAGE using magazines and newspapers.
